### **BASIC REQUIREMENTS FOR HEAVY VEHICLES USED FOR LESSONS AND TESTING**

(TO BE USED WHEN CLIENTS SUPPLIES TRUCK FOR LESSONS AND OR TESTING)

I am aware that it is a government requirement that all vehicles used for commercial licence lessons and testing are roadworthy.

I understand that presenting an un-roadworthy vehicle for lessons will cause lessons to be cancelled and all lesson fees to be forfeited.

I understand that presenting an un-roadworthy vehicle for testing will cause this test to be cancelled and all fees associated with this test to be forfeited.

I understand any vehicle used for lessons and testing must display L plates clearly visible to the front and rear of the vehicle. These plates are to be fitted prior to lessons and testing by the learner and are not the responsibility of the instructor. (Some vehicles are difficult to attach L plates to, if unsure speak to the instructor prior to the lesson or test date)

**I understand that the vehicle I am presenting needs to ensure that the following operate correctly and show no defects:**

- Lighting to front and rear (and side lights if fitted) are to be operating correctly and lens glass not to be missing or cracked. Lights to be clean of dirt and grime build up.
- Headlights, indicators, reverse lights, brake lights to be operating and checked prior to lessons or testing.
- Horn to operate correctly.
- Tyres to show at least 5mm of tread all round.
- Windscreens and windows to be clean and not cracked.
- All mirrors to be in place (Rear/Side L+R) to be clean and not cracked.
- Cabin to be clean and tidy.
- Brakes to operate correctly, including any handbrake, (without air leaks.)

#### **Loading For Test & Compliance – MR, HR & HC**

I understand that it is a government requirement that all Medium Rigid, Heavy Rigid and Heavy Combination vehicles are 75% laden during testing. These loads must be safely secured in accordance with all relevant law and legislation. HC Trailers must comply with minimum length of 11 metres.

(Please note Light Rigid vehicles do not need to be loaded, also buses are exempt from this requirement)

I also understand that I need to provide sticks to undertake reverse parallel parking manoeuvres when undertaking testing in light rigid or medium rigid vehicles.

**Please note:** A government auditor from DPTI may be present for any commercial test. Please be aware that if you are using your own truck and it only has 2 seats fitted a 20 minute audit drive may be necessary prior to your test. These audits are conducted at random by the government regulating body DPTI. There is no additional fee and these audits are compulsory when requested.

**Clients are advised that if conducting test in own LR/MR vehicle they need to provide sticks for the Reversed Parallel Parking Manoeuvre. Sticks are available on the day of the test from Accustoms office for a \$20 deposit which will be returned upon exchange of sticks.**
